

Our Development Cooperation with Tokelau



Our shared vision with Tokelau is building stronger governance and more effective public services, enhancing inter-atoll connectivity, and adapting to and mitigating the effects of climate change.

Recent achievements

- ✕ New wharfs and channels have been completed in Atafu and Nukunonu and are under construction in Fakaofu, ensuring safer access to shore in all weathers.
- ✕ Gifted a new inter-atoll boat to Tokelau which has significantly cut down travel time between the atolls.

Current development priorities

- ✕ Tokelau is well supported to improve its climate change resilience and mitigation.
- ✕ Core public service governance, management and service delivery is improved.
- ✕ Tokelau's transport and internet connectivity is improved.

What we are working on now

- ✕ Health sector review is under way considering how Tokelau can support the health of its people most effectively.
- ✕ An Education Summit is planned for 2019 to discuss future directions for Education in Tokelau.
- ✕ Planning underway to reduce the risks of coastal inundation from storms and climate change induced sea-level rise.
- ✕ Continuing to support Tokelau to sustainably maximise the revenue it receives from its valuable fisheries resources.
- ✕ Co-financing an undersea internet cable, to provide faster and more reliable internet. This will offer opportunities in tele-medicine and distance learning.
