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Required information guidance

State and Military Aircraft - Diplomatic Clearances are required for state aircraft undertaking activities that are governmental in character (i.e. not commercial activities), and for state military aircraft.

Definition - "Aircraft" means any machine that can derive support in the atmosphere from the reactions of the air; and includes any aeroplane, unmanned aerial vehicle (UAV), balloon, kite balloon, airship or glider.

Requesting Country – Please indicate the country applying for clearance

Point of Contact – Please add the name, email address and phone number of the draftee or best contact to discuss any further information regarding the flight.

Purpose – Please indicate the purpose of flight, i.e. VIP transport, cargo transport etc. If the aircraft is supporting or participating in an exercise or operation please indicate the name of the exercise or operation.

Operator – Please indicate the operator of the aircraft and their nationality. If the operator is civil registered, please include their address.

Aircraft – Please provide the registration, type of aircraft and call sign the aircraft will be using within New Zealand airspace.

Alternate Aircraft (if required) - Please provide the registration, type of aircraft and call sign the aircraft will be using within New Zealand airspace.

To New Zealand – These are the details for the flight to New Zealand. Please indicate the last airfield prior to arrival in New Zealand with the estimated time and date of departure and the point of entry into New Zealand airspace with the estimated time and date of entry. Times and dates should be in New Zealand Local Time. UTC times and dates can be indicated in brackets and marked UTC.

Itinerary In New Zealand – Please detail all landing ports within New Zealand with the estimated time and date of arrival and departure from these airfields. Times and dates should be in New Zealand Local Time. UTC times and dates can be indicated in brackets and marked UTC.

From New Zealand - These are the details for the flight from New Zealand. Please indicate the point of exit from New Zealand airspace with the estimated time and date of exit and the first airfield after departure for New Zealand with the estimated time and date of entry. Times and

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dates should be in New Zealand Local Time. UTC times and dates can be indicated in brackets and marked UTC.

Route – Please detail the air route the aircraft will fly over New Zealand airspace.

Captain – Please indicate captain's title (or rank), first and last name.

Crew and Passengers – Please provide crew numbers (less the captain's named above) and passenger numbers (less the VIPs named below).

VIP – Please provide any VIP details. Where the VIPs are only on board for part of the mission, the legs in which they will be travelling should be specified in the additional information section of the form.

Weapons – Please indicate if weapons are being carried on the flight. If no weapons are carried please check the box at the top of the field. If weapons are being carried please detail the type and number of weapons. Where such cargo is not being carried on all legs of the journey, the weapons being carried for each journey segment should be specified in the additional information section of the form.

Photographic, Electro-optical or other Observation Equipment – Excluding equipment used for the normal flight operation of the aircraft, any electronic, photo-sensory or other observation or sensor equipment which will be on board and in use should be detailed in this section. Military aircraft exercising or operating with the NZDF are excluded from this requirement. If no such equipment is carried please check the box at the top of the field.

Dangerous Goods - Please indicate if dangerous goods (DG) are being carried on the flight. If no DG are being carried please check the box at the top of the field. If DG are being carried please detail the class, name, Net Explosive Quantity (in kilograms) and United Nations (UN) number in the right hand columns. Where such cargo is not being carried on all legs of the journey the DG that are carried for each journey segment should be specified in the additional information section of the form.

Additional Information – This section has been provided for any additional information on the flight which may be pertinent to the granting of diplomatic clearance, such as any request for clearance time-delay.

Logistics and Ground Handling - Please note that while logistics and ground handling information or requirements can be provided in this section for information, it is the responsibility of the requesting country to organize such requirements themselves or in conjunction with their New Zealand host (after direct liaison with that host). The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade Point of Contact for processing the diplomatic clearance request will not assume responsibility for, or pass on, logistic or handling requirements.
