
Some NTMs are becoming impediments to trade (NTBs)

Measure implemented in 2nd half 2011 caused decline of rice exports by Economy A in 2012


- Supply constraints in overseas markets, economies to find alternative rice sources
- Increase of rice prices due to importance of "economy A" in world rice market



Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation

Some NTMs are becoming impediments to trade (NTBs)

Example: Import licensing requirements by Economy B on optical disc mastering and replicating machines (HS 847790)



Economy B: HS 847790 Imports (USD million)

- Measure implemented in March 2013
- Imports fell in 2013 and 2014
- Imports **went down** by 30.5% between 2012 and 2014 (USD 149 million)






Options to NTMs to address similar policy objectives
