Proposed Overseas Travel: Rt Hon Winston Peters - October/November 2025

Portfolio Foreign Affairs

On 13 October 2025, Cabinet:

- authorised the absence of the Rt Hon Winston Peters from New Zealand, from 19 October to 2 November 2025, to travel to the United Kingdom, Iceland, Finland, Norway, Sweden, and Denmark to undertake bilateral visits;
- agreed that he be accompanied by three members of staff from his office, one of whose costs will be met by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade;
- approved the estimated expenditure of up to \$116,534 for the travel expenses of the ministerial party as a charge to Vote Internal Affairs (Members of the Executive Travel);
- 4 **noted** that he will also be accompanied by officials from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade, whose travel costs will be met by their agency;
- 5 **agreed** that in his absence:
 - 5.1 Hon Todd McClay act as Minister of Foreign Affairs from 19 to 28 October 2025;
 - 5.2 Hon Mark Patterson act as Minister of Foreign Affairs from 29 October to 2 November 2025;
 - 5.3 Hon Mark Patterson act as Minister for Rail from 19 to 22 October 2025;
 - 5.4 Hon Simeon Brown act as Minister for Rail from 23 October to 2 November 2025;
 - 5.5 Hon Mark Patterson act as Minister for Racing;
- 6 **noted** that the House is sitting during his absence.

Proposed Overseas Travel: Rt Hon Winston Peters – October-November 2025

- 1 Cabinet approval is sought to travel to United Kingdom, Iceland, Norway, Denmark, Sweden, and Finland from Sunday 19 October to Sunday 2 November 2025 (inclusive).
- 2 The Prime Minister's Office has approved the travel in-principle.

Purpose of Travel

- The purpose of the travel is to undertake bilateral engagements in all six destination countries and engage in the inaugural New Zealand-Nordic 5 meeting.
- Our travel to London and meeting with new Foreign Secretary Yvette Cooper will be a chance to underline New Zealand's value as a reliable and trusted partner in support of the rules-based international order. Engagements during the visit will identify where New Zealand and the United Kingdom foreign policy priorities intersect and will allow an opportunity to discuss practical cooperation in support of shared objectives. We will be able to register several New Zealand requests with the Foreign Secretary Cooper and seek her support.
- Our travel to Iceland, Norway, Sweden, Finland and Denmark will consist of bilateral engagements at each destination and the first ever New Zealand-Nordic 5 meeting. These meetings will emphasis the importance of the international rules-based order, including existing close cooperation at the United Nations and in other multilateral fora, in order to preserve and protect elements of key significance to the Nordic 5 and New Zealand.
- Meetings will allow for exchange perspectives on key strategic challenges for our respective regions, including polar governance, geopolitical issues, and national security and resilience. We will also leverage existing linkages and strong alignment to build partnerships in science, technology, and innovation by advancing education, research, and space cooperation, and expand collaboration across key sectors including polar sciences, energy, transport, and manufacturing.

Outline of proposed visit

- 7 We intend to undertake the following key engagements:
 - 7.1 United Kingdom:

- the annual New Zealand–United Kingdom Foreign Ministers' Dialogue;
- Bilateral meeting with Foreign Secretary Cooper;
- Participate in the Oxford Union Debate;
- 7.2 Iceland, Norway, Denmark, Sweden, and Finland:
 - Hold the first New Zealand-Nordic 5 meeting with counterparts followed by a press conference;
 - Undertake bilateral engagement with ministerial counterparts:
 - Iceland President Halla Tómasdóttir;
 - Norwegian Foreign Minister Eide;
 - Danish Foreign Minister Rasmussen;
 - Swedish Foreign Minister Stenergard;
 - Finnish Speaker of the Parliament of Finland Halla-aho,
 Minister of Foreign Affairs Elina Valtonen;
 - Meet with a range of other important interlocutors and business leaders across the region;
 - Deliver an address to the Swedish Institute of International Affairs.

Ministerial Party

- We propose that the Senior Ministerial Adviser and my spouse join the delegation. Their travel costs would be a charge to Vote Internal Affairs: Members of the Executive Travel.
- This paper proposes that my Senior Foreign Affairs Adviser and officials from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade also travel in support of the visit objectives. Their costs would be covered by the Ministry.
- The delegation would depart for United Kingdom on Sunday 19 October on a commercial service. We would then travel to Iceland, Norway, Denmark, Sweden, and Finland, returning to New Zealand on Sunday 2 November also via commercial services.
