I refer to your request of 24 July 2022 to Te Kawa Mataaho Public Service Commission (PSC). On 5 August 2022, under the Official Information Act 1982, the PSC partially transferred the following to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade for response:

How much money was administered to the islands of Tokelau to combat the Covid-19 threat?

Since March 2020, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade (the Ministry) has provided NZ\$4,641,000 to support Tokelau's preparedness and response to COVID-19. This included grant funding to the Government of Tokelau to procure surge health-workforce support and medical equipment, procuring a medical container laboratory, and related staff training.

The Ministry also funded comprehensive technical and operational support to roll out COVID-19 immunisation in Tokelau, complementing New Zealand's donation of COVID-19 vaccines, as well as public health advisory support through the New Zealand Ministry of Health and managed by the Polynesian Health Corridors programme.
