- `Details of each time the Ministry has engaged the services of Tatou NZ Ltd.
- Invoices for services paid from Tatou NZ Ltd. Specifically, the amounts and dates.
- Description of the work completed in each instance.
- What was the procurement process? How many other providers were considered?
- If ministerial sign off was required, please provide details of which Minister(s) signed off.'

According to the Ministry's accounts payable vendor records, we have never engaged or paid Tatou NZ Ltd for any services. Therefore we are refusing your request under section 18(e) of the OIA, as the information requested does not exist, or despite reasonable efforts to locate it, cannot be found.
