Please find attached the full Review Summary as supplied by Steph Dyhrberg, along with the Ministry's Response from the Secretary of Foreign Affairs and Trade, Chris Seed, and a recent message from Chris Seed to all MFAT staff regarding the Workplace Cultures programme.

Regarding the Review Summary, we have chosen to provide a summary of the full Report under sections 16(1) & (3) for reasons supported by the following sections of the OIA;

- 9(2)(a): to protect individuals' privacy;
- 9(2)(ba)(i): to protect the supply of confidential information by another party;
- 9(2)(b)(ii): to avoid prejudice to the commercial position of another party;
- 9(2)(g)(i): to protect the free and frank expression of opinions by departments

Where the information has been withheld under section 9 of the OIA, we have identified no public interest in releasing the information that would override the reasons for withholding it.
