I refer to your email of 20 February in which you request the following under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA):

'readily available data on the amount of flights taken by staff and/or spend from 2022 or 2021'

For the purposes of compiling an inventory of the Ministry's carbon emissions, 9,680 flights were identified in the 2021/22 financial year, up from 5,697 flights undertaken in the 2020/21 financial year. The inventory captures all point to point flights recorded in the travel codes of the Ministry's general ledger.

The Ministry's travel spending is published each year as part of the Foreign Affairs, Defence and Trade Committee's (FADTC) Annual Review process. The Ministry's response to the 2020/21 Annual Review questionnaire can be found on the Parliament website. Please refer to the "Training, Travel and Other Expenses" section (questions 96-99):
