- 2 agreed that he be accompanied by one member of staff;
- 3 approved the estimated expenditure of up to \$40,241 for the travel expenses of the Ministerial party as a charge to Vote: Internal Affairs (Members of the Executive – Travel);
- 4 **noted** that he will also be accompanied by two officials from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade, with their travel costs met by their department;
- 5 agreed that in his absence:
 - 5.1 Hon Andrew Little act as Minister for Land Information;
