a. Please provide a list of documents, including files, emails, memos, or any other relevant records, that separately contain the specified keywords from the year 2019 to the present date.

## 3. Format of Information:

a. I request that the information be provided in a format that includes the title or description of each document, along with the date of creation or receipt, and any additional metadata available.

## 4. Further Details:

a. If the list of documents containing the specified keywords is extensive, I am willing to submit separate requests for each year to facilitate the processing of information.'

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade (the Ministry) has no record of the information you have requested that "...contain[s] specific keywords related to unidentified aerial phenomena (UAP)
