"Please provide all internal analysis and correspondence by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade about Aotearoa's international obligations relating to ocean fertilisation, including any consideration of the 2013 amendment to the 1996 Protocol to the London Convention (Resolution LP 4(8))."

On 4 August 2025, we contacted you regarding the scope of your request and proposed the refinement of:

"Please provide all internal analysis and official correspondence by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade from 1 January 2025 onwards relating to Aotearoa New Zealand's international obligations in relation to ocean fertilisation, including any consideration of the 2013 amendment to the 1996 Protocol to the London Convention (Resolution LP 4(8))."
