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Kia ora \$9(2)(g)(ii),

Following <u>last weeks' announcement</u> that the US has placed sanctions on UN Special Rapporteur in the Occupied Palestinian Territories, Francesca Albanese, Palestine has requested that countries sign-up to the attached letter to the UN High Commissioner to Human Rights. GVA Formal Messages below also refer. Geneva has requested a decision by <u>COB today NZT.</u>

The letter outlines concerns with the unilateral sanctions placed on the Special Rapporteur and the precedent that this sets; rejects the "disinformation and baseless allegations of antisemitism, violence, terrorism and financial misconduct against the mandate holder;" and urges UN Member States to engage substantively and constructively with independent special rapporteurs rather than resort to punitive measures.

While New Zealand broadly supports the sentiment of the letter (particularly the concerning precedent being set with respect to the sanctioning of an independent expert appointed by the UN Human Rights Council), the letter itself includes language that goes beyond what we've previously supported S6(a)

Our recommendation is to not sign-up to the letter \$6(a)
