Thank you for your email of 29 September 2025, in which you request the following under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA):

"Please provide copies of all 2025 communications to MFAT and the minister of Foreign Affairs from the United States, including the US embassy in Wellington, regarding New Zealand's consideration of recognising a Palestinian state."

On 28 October 2025, the timeframes for responding to your request were extended by an additional 10 working days due to the consultations necessary to make a decision on your request (section 15A(1)(b) of the OIA refers).

Your request is refused under section 18(e) of the OIA, as the information requested does not exist.
