Thank you for your email of 1 October 2025 in which you request the following under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA):

"Under the Official Information Act, please supply a list of all formal briefings sent to the Minister of Foreign Affairs by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade between 1-30 September 2025."

Between 1-30 September 2025, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade (the Ministry) provided 73 briefings to the Minister of Foreign Affairs.

A list of the 41 briefing titles able to be released is attached as Appendix One.

A further 32 briefing titles are withheld in full under the following sections of the OIA: 6(a): to avoid prejudicing the security or defence of New Zealand or the international relations of the New Zealand Government;

- 6(b)(i): to protect the passing of information from another government on a confidential basis;
- 6(d): to endanger the safety of any person;
- 7(a)(iv): to avoid prejudicing the security or defence of the Ross Dependency;
- 9(2)(f)(iv): to protect the confidentiality of advice tendered by Ministers of the Crown and officials, and
- 9(2)(j): to avoid prejudice to negotiations.

Where the information has been withheld under section 9 of the OIA, no public interest in releasing the information has been identified that would override the reasons for withholding it.
