Proposed Overseas Travel: Rt Hon Winston Peters - March 2025 ONAH

Portfolio **Foreign Affairs**

On 10 March 2025, Cabinet:

- authorised the absence of the Rt Hon Winston Peters from New Zealand from 13 to 21 1 March 2025, to travel to New York and Washington, the United States of America for bilateral visits;
- agreed that he be accompanied by two members of staff, 2
- 3 authorised the estimated expenditure of up to \$81,313 for the travel expenses of the Ministerial party as a charge to Vote Internal Affairs (Members of the Executive – Travel);
- noted that he will be accompanied by officials from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and 4 Trade, whose travel costs will be met by their agency;
- agreed that during his absence: 5
 - 51 Hon Judith Collins KC act as Minister of Foreign Affairs;
 - Hon Mark Patterson act as Minister for Racing; 5.2
 - Hon Chris Bishop act as Minister for Rail; 5.3
- 6 **noted** that the House is not sitting during his absence.

- 1 Cabinet approval is sought to undertake official travel to the US, departing Thursday 13 March and returning Friday 21 March 2025.
- The Prime Minister's Office has approved the travel in-principle 2

Purpose of Travel

3 The US remains an essential partner for New Zealand. s6(a)

This visit will be the first by a New Zealand Minister to Washington DC since President Trump started his second term and will be important in setting the tone (with the US, other partners, and in public) of the New Zealand-US relationship during this new era.

- 4 US Secretary of State Marco Rubio has offered a time on 18 March for a bilateral meeting. This would be the first in-person meeting with the new Secretary, following an introductory phone call shortly after Secretary Rubio's confirmation.
- The visit to Washington DC would be preceded by a visit to New York to 5 speak with senior officials and Permanent Representatives to the United Nations (UN). roactivelyre

7 In addition to the call on Secretary Rubio, we will be seeking the following engagements during the visit:

• Meetings with s6(a) Waltz, s6(a)

- Engagement with prominent US foreign policy commentators; and
- Meetings with senior UN officials, s6(a)

as well as Permanent Representatives of key partners such as Canada.

- 8 If travel is approved, we will depart for New York on the evening of Thursday 13 March and return to New Zealand on Friday 21 March 2025.
- 9 Several New Zealand media organisations have indicated that they intend to cover the visit in person.

Ministerial Party

10 If travel is approved, my Specialist Ministerial Adviser and Senior Press Secretary would accompany. Our costs will be charged to Vote Internal Affairs: Members of the Executive – Travel. My Senior Foreign Affairs Adviser and the Secretary of Foreign Affairs and Trade would also accompany. Their costs would be covered by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade.

Acting Ministers

11 If travel is approved, Hon Judith Collins KC will cover my foreign affairs portfolio, Hon Mark Patterson will cover my racing portfolio, and Hon Chris Bishop will cover my rail portfolio.
