On 6 October 2025, Cabinet:

- authorised the absence of Hon Chris Penk from New Zealand, from 8 to 12 October 2025 1 to Gqeberha, South Africa to attend the G20 Trade and Investment Ministerial Meeting on behalf of the Minister of Trade and Investment;
- 2 agreed that he be accompanied by one member of staff;
- 3 approved the estimated expenditure of up to \$39,480 for the travel expenses of the ministerial party as a charge to Vote Internal Affairs (Members of the Executive – Travel);
- **noted** that he will also be accompanied by officials from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and 4 Trade, whose costs will be met by their agency;
- 5 agreed that in his absence:
 - 5.1 Hon James Meager act as Minister for Building and Construction;
 - 5 2 Hon Scott Simpson act as Minister for Small Business and Manufacturing;
 - 5.3 Hon Nicola Grigg act as Minister for Land Information;
 - 5.4 Hon Penny Simmonds act as Minister for Veterans;
- noted that leave from the House has been approved.

Proposed Overseas Travel: Hon Chris Penk on behalf of Hon Todd McClay – G20 Trade and Investment Ministers Meeting October 2025

- I seek Cabinet approval for Hon Chris Penk to travel on my behalf to Gqeberha, South Africa from 8 October to 12 October.
- The Chief of Staff has approved the travel in-principle, and House leave has been approved from the Party Whip.

Purpose of Travel

- The purpose of Hon Penk's travel is to attend the annual Trade and Investment Ministers Meeting (TIMM) of the Group of 20 (G20). The TIMM is well-attended by trade and economic-focused Ministers and is a platform where the world's major economies try to collectively progress global trade challenges. This year's overarching theme, chosen by South Africa as 2025 host, is "Solidarity, Equality, Sustainability".
- While not a member of the G20, New Zealand was invited to participate as a guest in the Trade and Investment Workstream by South African President Cyril Ramaphosa. This invitation is a positive reflection of New Zealand's international reputation in the trade space, as well as the strength of our relationships with South Africa. New Zealand Ministerial attendance is an important opportunity to demonstrate New Zealand's support for the G20, including the work this year on strengthening the rules-based international trading system during turbulent times.
- On the margins of the meeting, Hon Penk will have the opportunity to engage with counterpart Ministers, including the Irish Minister of State for European Affairs and Defence, and undertake a short bilateral programme in Johannesburg enroute to Ggeberha.

Ministerial Party

He will be accompanied by a member of staff from his office. Hon Penk will also be supported by Officials from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade (MFAT) as required during travel. MFAT will cover the costs of their officials. All costs for MFAT will be covered from within the Ministry's baseline budget.
