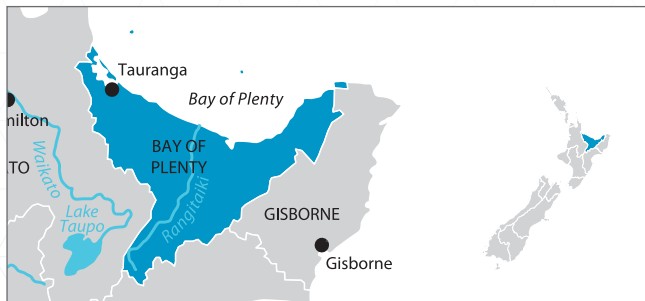

## Highlights for Bay of Plenty exporters include:



All tariffs on New Zealand forestry and forestry products will be eliminated as part of CPTPP, including in Japan (New Zealand's fourth-largest export market).



79% of New Zealand's kiwifruit crop is grown in the Bay of Plenty. All tariffs for New Zealand kiwifruit will be eliminated upon entry into force of the Agreement, and existing duty-free access will be locked in.



CPTPP will provide New Zealand improved access into the region for butter and cream where current access is highly restricted by high tariffs and small quotas. Malaysia will eliminate liquid milk tariffs over 16 years.



The Bay of Plenty is New Zealand's largest producer of avocados. All tariffs for avocados will be eliminated upon entry into force of the Agreement, and existing duty-free access will be locked in.



The CPTPP will also help address non-tariff barriers to trade in goods and services, including by streamlining the process to get goods across the border.
