

Business

- Option to self-declare origin to reduce compliance costs
- Faster customs clearance (max 6 hrs for perishables)
- Streamlined biosecurity & food safety rules
- Digital trade rules: data flows, privacy, e-commerce
- Greater transparency in customs rules

Māori & Indigenous Trade

Dedicated Māori and Indigenous Peoples Economic and Trade Cooperation chapter promotes cooperation for trade and investment, including agribusiness,

tourism and food, and support for business-to-business connections through trade missions.

Protection and promotion of Māori genetic resources, traditional knowledge, traditional cultural expressions and names and uses of plants, including mānuka.
